New to the library are two items which share the remarkable story of Corrie ten Boom and her family.

Corrie ten Boom: Shining in the Darkness
This book from HEROES FOR YOUNG READERS,

a colorfully illustrated series written in rhyming poems, shares how Corrie risked everything to extend God's hand of love and protection to her Jewish neighbors when Nazi Germany occupied Holland. A perfect hiding place was built into the wall of her bedroom, but would she have the courage to keep the secret, even if it meant she and her family would suffer greatly? In the darkest of nights, Corrie's compassion, sacrifice, and forgiving spirit were a shining testimony to the triumph of God's love over evil.

The Corrie ten Boom Story

This DVD from **THE TORCHLIGHTERS**, a series of animated programs especially for youth ages 8-12, shows Corrie and her family as masters of their craft as they repair broken watches and return them safely to their owners. CHAOS ON EARTH - Part 2

Ezekiel 38 and 39

Introduction

We are looking at an event that will happen between the Rapture and the beginning of the Tribulation. This event will be the catalyst for Israel's willingness to make a covenant with a man for seven years. He will be the Antichrist. They will not know he is the Antichrist

For the first three and one half years, the Antichrist will keep the covenant. The second three and one half years, he will seek to do everything in his power to annihilate the nation of Israel.

Immediately after the Rapture, the world will be in chaos.

- 1. A new world order will be established in which a world governing body, perhaps similar to the European Union, will divide the world into ten regions, each governed by a king. The Antichrist will not be given the privilege of being one of those ten kings.
- 2. The world economy will be in shambles. For some reason, Israel will not be affected in the same way many other countries will be affected.
- 3. The leader of Russia, whom God calls Gog, will assemble a coalition of nations to attack Israel and take the wealth of Israel to meet their own needs. We know many of the nations involved in this attack, but there could be others not named.

Ezekiel 38:5-6

- 5 Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya with them; all of them with shield and helmet:
- 6 Gomer, and all his bands; the house of Togarmah of the north quarters, and all his bands: and many people with thee.
- "Many people with thee" could refer to the army of Russia or to mercenary soldiers from other nations not named.
- 4. Israel will be dwelling in peace, which makes her vulnerable.

Ezekiel 38:8, 11, 14

8 After many days thou shalt be visited: in the latter years thou shalt come into the land that is brought back from the sword, and is gathered out of many people, against the mountains of **Israel**,

which have been always waste: but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

- 11 And thou shalt say, I will go up to the land of unwalled villages; I will go to them that are at rest, that dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates,
- 14 Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say unto Gog, Thus saith the Lord GOD; <u>In that day when my people of Israel dwelleth safely</u>, shalt thou not know it?
- It is particularly notable that Israel's immediate neighbors are not named as participants in this attack. It appears that the middle east peace agreement has been achieved.
- 5. This massive military force will cover Israel like a storm.

Ezekiel 38:9

9 Thou shalt ascend and come like a storm, thou shalt be like a cloud to cover the land, thou, and all thy bands, and many people with thee.

The massive military force could be as big as 10, 20, or 30 million personnel. The reason such a massive force is needed is because the modern technical equipment appears not to be available to them.

Ezekiel 38:4, 15

- 4 And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts of armour, even a great company with bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:
- 15 And thou shalt come from thy place out of the north parts, thou, and many people with thee, <u>all</u> <u>of them riding upon horses</u>, a great company, and a mighty army:
- 6. With such and overwhelming force, this coalition of predominately Moslem nations will think it impossible for them to lose. As this army steps on Israeli soil, let's see what happens.

I. EARTHQUAKE AND CHAOS

A. After the invading army reaches Israel, but before they can attack, God causes a great earthquake in the land of Israel. Ezekiel 38:19-23

19 For in my jealousy and in the fire of my wrath have I spoken, Surely in that day there shall be a great shaking in the land of Israel;

20 So that the fishes of the sea, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the field, and all creeping things that creep upon the earth, and all the men that are upon the face of the earth, shall shake at my presence, and the mountains shall be thrown down, and the steep places shall fall, and every wall shall fall to the ground.

- 1. Verse 19 specifies that this earthquake is localized in the land of Israel.
- 2. Both the sea of Galilee and the Mediterranean Sea may be affected.
- 3. Fish, animals of all kinds, and people alike will shake throughout the land of Israel.
- 4. Mountains will be thrown down.
- 5. Steep places will fall.
- 6. Every wall in Israel will fall to the ground.

This cannot be referring to walls around the perimeter of cities as in ancient times. Verse 11 says they are dwelling in unwalled villages, without walls, without bars or gates. Verse 20 has to be referring to the walls of buildings, just as typically happens in earthquakes. Note the significance of **EVERY WALL** falling down in Israel. This will have to include the mosque on the temple mount freeing up the mount for the rebuilding of Israel's temple. But it will also make Israel even more vulnerable. They will have a massive clean up job and at the same time, no longer feel safe.

B. The earthquake will totally confuse the invading army and create chaos in their ranks.

Ezekiel 38:21

- 21 And I will call for a sword against him throughout all my mountains, saith the Lord GOD: every man's sword shall be against his brother.
- C. On top of this, God will cause an horrific storm from the sky to add further confusion to the situation.

Ezekiel 38:22

22 And I will plead against him with pestilence and with blood; and I will rain upon him, and upon his bands, and upon the many people that are with him, an overflowing rain, and great hailstones, fire, and brimstone.

Pestilence refers to great physical injury being imposed on many in this army. The wounds from the earthquake and the storm that will follow will make them a bloody mess. With the overflowing rain, there will be flash floods, great hailstones, fire and brimstone. Hailstones can get very large. The largest hailstones on record have been as big as 17 inches in diameter and weigh as much as a pound and a half. It is hard to imagine hailstones that large or larger falling from the sky in a great quantity, or how much it will hurt when they hit people. Brimstone is made up of Sulphur: a hard, brittle, inflammable substance, of a lemon yellow color, which has no smell, unless heated, and which becomes negatively electric by heat and friction. It is found, in great quantities, and sometimes pure, in the neighborhood of volcanoes. When the balls of brimstone/sulphur fall from the sky mix with fire, the result will be sulphur oxides which put off obnoxious odors and cause acid rain. All of this will create a horrible situation for the people on the ground.

D. This catastrophic event will be so horrific, the only conclusion possible is that it is caused by God.

Ezekiel 38:23

23 Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the LORD.

II. DISASTER FOR THE INVADERS

A. God directed Ezekiel to declare disaster upon Gog and his followers.

Ezekiel 39:1

- 1 Therefore, thou son of man, prophesy against Gog, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:
- B. Five sixths of the invading army will be killed. Ezekiel 39:2
 - 2 And I will turn thee back, and leave but the sixth part of thee, and will cause thee to come up from the north parts, and will bring thee upon the mountains of Israel:
- C. The invading army will lose its entire arsenal of weaponry.

Ezekiel 39:3

3 And I will smite thy bow out of thy left hand, and will cause thine arrows to fall out of thy right hand.

- D. Many of the dead will fall in the mountains. Ezekiel 39:4
 - 4 Thou shalt fall upon the mountains of Israel, thou, and all thy bands, and the people that is with thee: I will give thee unto the ravenous birds of every sort, and to the beasts of the field to be devoured.

It appears that Gog himself will die, as verse includes, "Thou, and all thy bands, and the people that is with thee". Since verse 1 of chapter 39 says this is a prophecy against God, "thou" in verse 4 undoubtedly refers to him.

- E. Some of the dead will fall in the open field. Ezekiel 39:5
 - 5 Thou shalt fall upon the open field: for I have spoken it, saith the Lord GOD.
- F. In addition, God will set on fire the land of Magog. Ezekiel 39:6
 - 6 And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: and they shall know that I am the LORD.

God will then expand the effect of this event upon those dwelling carelessly in the isles. "Carelessly" is identical in meaning to "safely" as Israel will be dwelling safely in chapter 38. This will be a wake up call to the world and a precursor to the opening of the seal judgments in Revelation chapter 6.

- G. When the 70th week of Daniel actually begins, and Christ begins to open the seal judgments upon the world (Revelation chapter 6), God wants everyone to know exactly who is causing all of the chaos on earth.
 - Ezekiel 39:6
 - 6 And I will send a fire on Magog, and among them that dwell carelessly in the isles: **and they shall know that I am the LORD.**
 - 7 So will I make my holy name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my holy name any more: and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, the Holy One in Israel.

III. A MESS FOR ISRAEL

With every wall in Israel fallen down, this will include, government buildings, schools, businesses, homes, etc. Every structure will be destroyed. Besides this, there will be dead bodies of men and horses all over the country. Weapons will be lying around everywhere. Mountains have been tumbled down and

the entire landscape will be changed. Israel will be in total chaos.

A. God points out that He prophesied this would happen.

Ezekiel 39:8

- 8 Behold, it is come, and it is done, saith the Lord GOD; this is the day whereof I have spoken.
- B. It will take seven years to clean up the weapons left behind.

Ezekiel 39:9

- 9 And they that dwell in the cities of Israel shall go forth, and shall set on fire and burn the weapons, both the shields and the bucklers, the bows and the arrows, and the handstaves, and the spears, and they shall burn them with fire seven years:
- 10 So that they shall take no wood out of the field, neither cut down any out of the forests; for they shall burn the weapons with fire: and they shall spoil those that spoiled them, and rob those that robbed them, saith the Lord GOD.
- 1. They will burn the weapons for fuel.

This will include shields, bucklers, bows, arrows, handstaves, and spears. This sounds like primitive weapons for such a modern time. Some assign this catastrophe to Antiochus Epiphanes. Reformed theology contends that this was fulfilled in the distant past. Those who see it as future sometimes relegate these words to a figurative meaning and don't take them literally.

It is, of course, yet future. It is in the latter times. And why not literal? Didn't God know that weapons would change through the years? Wouldn't He in some clever way be able to describe modern weapons in prophecy?

Of course He could. For whatever reason that we may not be able to see now, this invading army will be riding horses and using weapons like shields, bucklers, bows, arrows, handstaves, and spears. The chaos of the world immediately following the Rapture will cause a lot of things to happen that we cannot reason through at this point in time.

2. Israel will take the spoil from the enemy that intended to take a spoil from Israel.

3. Note the period of seven years.

It does not seem coincidental that the tribulation period, which is the 70th week of Daniel's prophecy, lasts for seven years, and that it will take seven years for Israel to burn up all the weapons left behind by the invading army. This is one of the reasons we should believe that the events of Ezekiel chapters 38 and 39 take place just prior to the beginning of the tribulation period.

- C. Burying the dead will be a massive project.
- A place will be designated for burial. Ezekiel 39:11

11 And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will give unto Gog a place there of graves in Israel, the valley of the passengers on the east of the sea: and it shall stop the noses of the passengers: and there shall they bury Gog and all his multitude: and they shall call it the valley of Hamongog.

Hamon means multitude. Hamongog means this burying place will be called "The valley of Gog's Multitude" (Hamongog).

2. It will take seven months for burial.

Ezekiel 39:12

12 And seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land.

3. At first, all Israelites will participate in the burial and all Israel will recognize God's personal involvement in this event.

Ezekiel 39:13

13 Yea, all the people of the land shall bury them; and it shall be to them a renown the day that I shall be glorified, saith the Lord GOD.

It will make such an impression on the Israelites that many of them will recognize the hand of God in this event. This could be why 144,000 Jews are ready to serve the Lord at the beginning of the Tribulation.

4. Following the initial burials of the piles of dead bodies, men will be employed to search out remaining dead bodies throughout the land.

Ezekiel 39:14-17

14 And they shall sever out men of continual employment, passing through the land to bury with the passengers those that remain upon the face of the earth, to cleanse it: after the end of seven months shall they search.

- 15 And the passengers that pass through the land, when any seeth a man's bone, then shall he set up a sign by it, till the buriers have buried it in the valley of Hamongog.
- 5. A city named Hamonah will be built in the valley of Hamongog.

Ezekiel 39:16

16 And also the name of the city shall be Hamonah. Thus shall they cleanse the land.

Hamonah will be the "city of the multitude".

D. Until the bodies are buried, scavenger birds and beasts will have their fill.

Ezekiel 39:17-20

- 17 And, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD; Speak unto every feathered fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, even a great sacrifice upon the mountains of Israel, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood.
- 18 Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of lambs, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan.
- 19 And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.
- 20 Thus ye shall be filled at my table with horses and chariots, with mighty men, and with all men of war, saith the Lord GOD.

IV. GLORY FOR GOD

A. The Gentiles of the world will know that God did this.

Ezekiel 39:21

21 And I will set my glory among the <u>heathen</u>, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them.

This will prepare the world to know that the catastrophes which continue into the Tribulation are from the hand of God.

B. Israel will know that God did this.

Ezekiel 39:22

22 So the house of Israel shall know that I am the LORD their God from that day and forward.

This will prepare the entire nation, or at least the majority of it, to want the temple built and the nation return to their ancient ways of worshiping God.

- C. The Gentiles will know from this that God has restored Israel to its land.
- 1. They will know that Israel suffered defeat in the past because of their sin.

Ezekiel 39:23-24

23 And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they trespassed against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword.

24 According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them.

2. They will know that God brought Israel back into the land.

Ezekiel 39:25-26

25 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD: Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy name;

26 After that they have borne their shame, and all their trespasses whereby they have trespassed against me, when they dwelt safely in their land, and none made them afraid.

3. Israel will know their God once again.

Ezekiel 39:27-28

27 When I have brought them again from the people, and gathered them out of their enemies' lands, and am sanctified in them in the sight of many nations:

28 Then shall they know that I am the LORD their God, which caused them to be led into captivity among the heathen: but I have gathered them unto their own land, and have left none of them any more there.

4. In the end, Israel will be saved and blessed. Ezekiel 39:29

29 Neither will I hide my face any more from them: for I have poured out my spirit upon the house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD.

Conclusion

What are the implications of this failed invasion of Israel and the terrible mess that will exist in the land of Israel as a result?

Israel will be ready as a nation to build the temple and restart the Old Testament sacrifices. Today, they are not there yet. According to a poll taken in a leading newspaper Ha'aretz, one third of Israelis believe that Israel should erect the Temple on the Temple Mount. But believing they should do it and having the will to do it can be two very different things.

Israel will be ready to make a covenant with someone to provide security for them while they rebuild as a nation. This will be the covenant with the Antichrist spoken of by Daniel in his prophecy of the 70 weeks.

Daniel 9:27

27 And he [the Antichrist] shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.

When we pray for the peace of Israel, we must understand that Israel as a nation must go through the last seven years of Daniel's prophecy before they can really experience peace. But Israel will come through it all and will survive as God's chosen nation on the earth. In spite of the chastisement God will put His people through, God will still love the nation of Israel and will ultimately keep all of His promises to the nation and the land, the people and the place where He chose to inscribe His name on the earth.

"Whether One May Flee From a Deadly Plague," By Martin Luther, Luther's Works, Vol. 43.

"Very well, by God's decree the enemy has sent us poison and deadly offal. Therefore I shall ask God mercifully to protect us. Then I shall fumigate, help purify the air, administer medicine, and take it. I shall avoid places and persons where my presence is not needed in order not to become contaminated and thus perchance infect and pollute others, and so cause their death as a result of my negligence. If God should wish to take me, He will surely find me and I have done what He has expected of me and so I am not responsible for either my own death or the death of others. If my neighbor needs me, however, I shall not avoid place or person but will go freely, as stated above. See, this is such a God-fearing faith because it is neither brash nor foolhardy and does not tempt God. Moreover, he who has contracted the disease and recovered should keep away from others and not admit them into his presence unless it be necessary. Though one should aid him in his time of need, as previously pointed out, he in turn should, after his recovery, so act toward others that no one becomes unnecessarily endangered on his account and so cause another's death. 'Whoever loves danger,' says the wise man, 'will perish by it."

Teacher's Assistance Program

2020 is the 35th anniversary of Tap Ministries Incorporated. Jim and Emma Turner began TAP out of their home here in Harrisburg in 1985. We praise the Lord that He has seen fit to use this ministry for His work for the last 35 years, and we endeavor to continue shipping materials to the mission field until He returns! Praise the Lord!

Our constant request is for more supporters. Each month we see more materials donated to TAP than the funds needed to ship those materials. We have seen an increase in our support level in each of the last two years, but we are still far behind where this ministry was in the 1990's.

We were able to ship our special Sunday School material shipment to India. Shipping was delayed two weeks due to shipping problems in India, but we were able to finally see the boxes picked up, and we prayed for them to arrive as planned even with the turmoil that often plagues these areas.

As Regular Baptist Press updated all of their curriculum over the last year, we have outlets to send the old style. Several churches already sent us their old material and this was what we sent on this special shipment to India.

Our Bible Institute is growing each year. We have the classes in the classroom at Castellbisbal, but since last year we opened a campus on-line where 102 students follow some of the classes. The Lord provided for us to have a better platform that will allow us to have a better service and help more students. I have called this platform EMOL (Escuela Ministerial On-line). I truly believe that there is a great need of good sound Bible centered Bible Institutes to help the Spanish speaking churches in Spain, South America and even in the United States.

We received a new family in our congregation. Manolo and Schumayk have been missionaries in Uruguay for 25 years. Now they have returned to Spain to work from our church reaching the Jewish people In the area of Barcelona. We are panning a visit to Israel as well once a year.

The last two years I was able to go to Israel helping a Spanish speaking church in Tel Aviv and sharing the good news of salvation with Spanish speaking people in the land. I would like to continue reaching the Jews with the Gospel of Christ. We will need to be led by the Lord in the next year in order to see our vision accomplished.

The Lord is opening doors we would have never imagined in ministry outside our own country. The need of the Spanish speaking churches is overwhelming. They need trained leadership and there are not theological schools or Bible seminaries This year I have been invited to teach in different conferences in the States, Chile, Peru and Uruguay. This is a great blessing, but also a great challenge. We would appreciate very much your prayers for us.

I have published more of my books about the cancer. I have to translate it to English, but I have not been able to do that yet. I continue praying and talking with many people that have gone through a cancer experience, and the Lord has used the book in a precious way.

During the club hour, the children sings songs, hear an exciting missionary story, memorize a verse of Scripture, participate in a review activity and listen to a lesson from God's Word. Visual aids, puppets, and various learning activities are used.

God could use the preaching to call young people to full-time Christian service or even use it to encourage churches in what they are already doing for the Lord. One of the highlights of this year will be a ten-day trip I take in May to the Amazon basin area of Colombia. We covet your prayer in advance that God would prepare the team and the villages where we will be, so that we can see many people come to a knowledge of Christ and be saved.





Teen Bible Quizzing

We are studying the book of I Peter this year.







For January and February we had a girls team and a boys team. Ten questions are asked in each quiz and the first to jump is the one who gets to answer. If they answer correctly they get 20 points for their team. When a quizzer answers three correctly in a quiz they can no longer jump - they have quizzed out. If there is a substitute they may take the place of the quizzer that has quizzed out.

When a question is asked, the quizzer has to quickly process the information that they have studied. When an error has been made the question then goes to the person on the opposite team who is sitting in the same position as the one who made the error. This is called a bonus. If the second team answers the bonus correctly they get 10 points added to their team score.
